SIR: In compliance with instructions,* I forward herewith a Descriptive Statement of changes which I propose to make, subject to your approval, among the School Employés at this Agency.

U. S. Indian Agent.

^{*}Instructions to Agents require that every change of employés shall be reported to the Commissioner, for his action, at the time such change takes place.

In the descriptive statement, the SEX may be designated by the letter M for male and F for female; the RACE by W for white, N for negro, I for Indian, H for half-breed, C for Chinese, &c.; the correct AGE is to be given when known—when it is estimated, a line should be drawn under the figures; S designates single, and M married.

The reports of "Changes in School Employés" are not to be considered as a substitute for "Quarterly Reports of School Employés." The latter must be made regularly and promptly, without regard to these.
