Recipients of Honorary Doctorates

Honorable Lynne V. Cheney

As chairman of the National Endowment for the Humanities, Lynne V. Cheney directs an independent federal agency with a \$138 million budget that provides grants to scholars, colleges, museums, libraries and other cultural institutions to support research, education and public programs in the humanities. She has spoken and published extensively (Newsweek, The Wall Street Journal, The Washington Post, The Christian Science Monitor, and The Washington Times) on the value of liberal arts to one's profession and personal life.

She has also directed the Endowment's comprehensive assessment of humanities education in America's elementary and secondary schools (released in September 1987), and served as a member of the Commission on the Bicentennial of the United States Constitution.

Before coming to NEH, Mrs. Cheney taught at several colleges and universities and was a magazine editor and a widely published author. She has written many articles that have appeared in national publications, including *American Heritage* and *Smithsonian* magazines, and has worked as a researcher/writer for public television. She is the author of two novels, *Executive Privilege* and *Sisters*, and the co-author with her husband, Representative Richard Cheney (R-Wyo.), of *Kings of the Hill*, a history of the House of Representatives.

She is a native of Wyoming and graduated from Natrona County High School in Casper, Wyoming. She earned her bachelor's degree with highest honors from Colorado College and a doctoral degree with a specialty in 19th-century British literature, from the University of Wisconsin in 1970.

Russell E. Fuller

Russell E. Fuller is from Boylston, MA, where he and his wife, Joyce I. Fuller, have raised two sons, Mark W. and Lincoln E. Fuller.

Educated in local elementary schools, Mr. Fuller went on to North High School, took courses at Worcester Junior College, then served in World War II. He has taken several business and sales courses at various institutions of higher education throughout his life. He founded and serves as president of REFCO, Inc., an industrial supply house in Boylston and West Lebanon, NH.

Mr. Fuller is chairman and treasurer of the George F. and Sybil H. Fuller Foundation, which is known for its many charitable contributions. He is currently Chairman of the Board of Trustees of Worcester Memorial Hospital and a trustee of the Intercare Health System, Central New England College, and SMA Investment Trust.

He currently serves as a director of the Wyman-Gordon Company and the New England Diabetes Foundation of Worcester. He is a member of the Carbine Society of New England.

He has taken a major ongoing interest in the Town of Boylston, including serving as Town Selectman. He is deeply involved in the Boylston Congregational Church and has participated in many town musical reviews and theatrical presentations.

Mary C. Gordon

Featured in a U.S. News and World Report interview, "Growing up Catholic and Creative" (October 5, 1987), Mary C. Gordon "is considered to be among the nation's most gifted writers of fiction."

Random House has published her novels Final Payments (1978), The Company of Women (1980), Men and Angels (1985), and Temporary Shelter (1987)—all of them Literary Guild selections, and all later published by Ballentine as paperbacks. She has also published numerous short stories in national magazines including Ms., Mademoiselle, Harper's, Atlantic, Redbook, Ladies' Home Journal, and Virginia Quarterly Review. She is currently working on a new novel, Rose Tree, which will be published by Viking Penguin, Inc.

Born on Long Island, Mary received her BA degree from Barnard College and her MA degree from Syracuse University. She taught English at Dutchess Community College (1974–1978) and Amherst College (1979). She gives readings and lectures at colleges and universities throughout the nation and will be teaching at Barnard College, beginning this fall.

Mary resides with her husband, Arthur Cash, and children Anna and David in New Paltz, New York.

Roger P. Plourde

A Worcester native, Roger P. Plourde graduated from North High School. Following his service in the U.S. Navy he graduated from the College of the Holy Cross ('51), where he majored in Chemistry.

He is the founder and current president of Custom Coating and Laminating Corporation of Worcester, and founder and vice-president of Temp-Flex Corporation of South Grafton. He also founded Flexcon Corporation, in Spencer, where he served as president.

Mr. Plourde serves on the Board of Directors of W.C.I.S., is an incorporator of St. Vincent Healthcare Systems, Inc., and is a member of the Worcester Area Chamber of Commerce, Les Amis Des Bon Vins and La Confrèrie Des Chevaliers Des Tastevins, Worcester Chapter.

A resident of Paxton, Roger and his wife Gloria Peloquin Plourde have four children: Michele Waddill, Patricia Austin, Carolyn and Roger Jr.

Most Reverend George E. Rueger

The son of Edward and Mary (Reddy) Rueger, Bishop Rueger was born in Framingham, Massachusetts. He graduated from St. Peter's High School, Worcester, and attended Holy Cross College, Worcester, before beginning his studies for the priesthood at Cardinal O'Connell Seminary in Jamaica Plain, NY. He completed his theology studies at St. John's Seminary, Brighton, and was ordained to the priesthood by the then Bishop Wright on January 6, 1958, in St. Paul's Cathedral, Worcester. Bishop Rueger then obtained a master's degree in Philosophy from St. John's Seminary and did work in Education at Harvard University.

He was named associate pastor of Our Lady of Lourdes Parish, East Millbury, and of St. Peter's Parish, Worcester, before being named headmaster of Marian Central Catholic High School in June, 1965. He remained there until July of 1974, when he was appointed associate pastor of Our Lady of the Lake Parish Whalom.

He was elected president of the newly formed Diocesan Senate of Priests in April, 1976. In September 1977, Bishop Rueger was appointed pastor of Sacred Heart Parish, Hopedale. In July, 1978, he was appointed superintendent of Worcester Diocesan Schools where he served until 1981. Later that year, he was named pastor of St. Peter's Parish in Worcester. In January, 1987, he was appointed auxiliary bishop of Worcester and was ordained to the episcopacy on February 25, 1987 in St. Paul's Cathedral, Worcester, by Bishop Timothy J. Harrington. Co-consecrators: Bishop Bernard J. Flanagan, former Bishop of Worcester, and Bishop John A. Marshall of Burlington.

Bishop Rueger has served as vice president of the Worcester County Ecumenical Council, and for six years as a member of the Board of Elderly Affairs.
