# **Recipients of Honorary Doctorates**

#### Reverend Barbara W. Merritt

A 1975 graduate of the Thomas Starr King School for the Ministry, part of the Graduate Theological Union of Berkeley, CA., the Reverend Doctor Barbara Merritt has served as the senior minister of the First Unitarian Church of Worcester for nine years.

Well known for her service to the community, Reverend Merritt has worked with the indigent, disadvantaged and homeless. She has devoted considerable time and effort to various local homeless projects, including Jeremiah's Inn, Oasis House and the George Street transitional shelter for women and children.

A prominent speaker and a superb ecumenist, Reverend Merritt has preached before many different denominational groups and is an active member of the Downtown Clergy Association and the St. Wulstan Society, an ecumenical theological society in Worcester. She has been a guest lecturer at the Harvard Divinity School and is the author of several articles on issues of faith and spirituality. Reverend Merritt has also received an honorary doctoral degree in Theology from Thomas Starr King School for the Ministry.

Reverend Merritt lives in Worcester with her husband, Jeffrey, and her two sons, Robert and David.

#### Reverend Edgar A. Bourque, A.A.

Father Bourque has led a distinguished career serving Assumption and the community at large. After graduating from Assumption College in 1946, he taught at Assumption Preparatory School and pursued graduate studies at Laval University in Montreal, Canada.

He then returned to the United States in 1952 and has been actively involved with Assumption ever since. During this period, Father Bourque has been the headmaster of Assumption Prep, director of Formation for the Augustinians of Assumption, provincial of the North American Province of the Assumptionists, and a member of the Assumption College Board of Trustees. Most recently, he has overseen Assumption's counseling program as the director of Counseling and Career Planning and served as the chairman of the Theology Department.

In 1991, after many years of service, Father Bourque retired from teaching and was named professor emeritus of Theology.

Today, Father Bourque is the religious superior of the St. Augustine Community on Barry Road in Worcester, where he presently serves as novice master for candidates for the Assumption congregation. Father Bourque is the director of Assumption Communications, which researches and publishes articles on the life and writing of Emmanuel d'Alzon, founder of the Assumptionists. He is also the U.S. editor of Catholic International.

## Francis H. Dewey III

Born in Washington, D.C., Francis "Chuck" Dewey has been a local business and community leader for more than 40 years. Today, he continues to play a major role in shaping Worcester's future as the chairman of the George I. Alden Trust.

Mr. Dewey earned his A.B. degree at Williams College in 1941. After graduation, he served in the Army Air Force until 1946. Following his discharge, Mr. Dewey was employed at the Bank of Boston and later the Mechanics National Bank of Worcester. There his career culminated with a 12 year tenure as president.

During these years, he served on over 20 local boards--both corporate and non-profit. In addition, Mr. Dewey served his alma mater, Williams College, as vice president and treasurer from 1973 to 1981.

Mr. Dewey has also been a trustee of the George I. Alden Trust since 1970. Established in 1912 as a private foundation, the Trust provides grants to educational institutions and has been a benefactor of Assumption College for several years.

Mr. Dewey lives in Worcester with his wife, the former Frances B. Smith of Providence. They have four children and nine grandchildren.

#### George A. Doyle, Ph.D

A nationally known economist and foreign affairs specialist, Dr. George Doyle has brought considerable attention to Assumption College through his involvement in activities such as the Massachusetts Governors' Foreign Trade Council, the BLUTRADE project for regional growth, the Worcester Community Seminars, and the New England Regional Export Council.

Dr. Doyle has served the College in many important capacities since his arrival in 1961. He oversaw the development of the Department of Economics and Foreign Affairs and secured federal grants from the National Science Foundation's Institute on Economics to bring economics professors to the College five years in a row. In addition, Dr. Doyle served as the first chairman of the Faculty Senate and provided outstanding leadership to a number of College communities.

Dr. Doyle has twice been awarded the prestigious Fulbright professorship. In 1980-81, he taught at the University of Zambia and helped establish that institution's master's level program in International Economics. In 1988, he went to China where he taught Economics at the Shanghai International Studies University.

A gifted teacher, he has had a profound influence on a generation of Assumption students and inspired them to achieve success in a wide range of endeavors. In 1987, the George A. Doyle Scholarship was established by a group of colleagues, former students and friends in recognition of his outstanding contributions to the College and its students.

#### Reverend Richard E. Lamoureaux, A.A.

A native of Worcester, Father Richard Lamoureux has served Assumption College for many years, most recently as the vice president for Academic Affairs and dean of Faculty.

A 1964 graduate of Assumption College, he has taught at the College in the Department of Art and Music since it was established in 1975. He received the Bachelor of Sacred Theology degree from the Universita Gregoriana in Rome, the Master of Divinity in Theology from Boston College, the Master of Arts in 17th Century Italian Art from Boston University, and the Doctor of Philosophy in Art History from New York University's Institute of Fine Arts. He has published and lectured widely in his field.

In addition to these academic achievements, Father Richard has served his religious Congregation in a variety of ways. Most recently he served as the provincial superior of the North American Province of the Assumptionists from 1984-1990, and was responsible for the membership of his community in this country and in the Province's missions abroad. In this position he was also engaged in an number of international projects within the Order and in Church leadership efforts in this country.

### Arthur G. Simoneau, M.D.

An alumnus of both Assumption Preparatory School and Assumption College, Dr. Simoneau was class president for all eight years and a high honors graduate from the College in 1935. In 1939, Dr. Simoneau received his M.D. degree from Boston University School of Medicine. As a married man with four young children, he served with the 106th Evacuation Hospital in General Patton's 3rd U.S. Army in Europe during World War II.

After the war, Dr. Simoneau returned to his native Marlborough where he resumed his medical practice with full admitting privileges at Marlborough Hospital. In the course of his 42 year career, he assisted at some 2,000 births, carried on a full family practice, and served as chairman of the Medical Department, president of the hospital medical staff and president of the Massachusetts Academy of Family Physicians.

In addition to his outstanding community service, Dr. Simoneau has been an active member of Assumption's Alumni Advisory Board for over 15 years. Currently he serves as the special alumni ambassador. He has also been actively involved in development activities such as spearheading the capital campaign for the campus center and providing leadership support for the library campaign.




